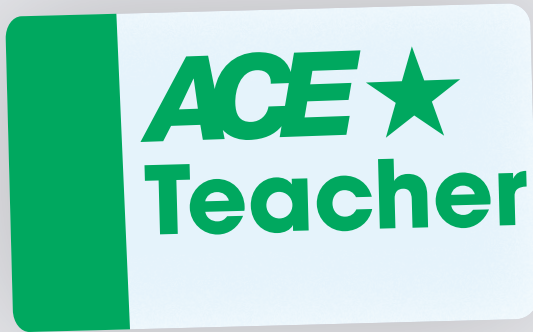

Teaching Quality

- **Maintain an inclusive classroom atmosphere that values every student's contribution.**
- **Facilitate diverse activities, including debates, filmmaking and storytelling sessions, to make learning engaging and interactive.**
- **Regularly monitor and assess student progress and adapt your approach as necessary.**
- **Team Coordination: Participate in daily brief meetings with the team to ensure a cohesive approach to the day's objectives and to foster open communication.**

As an ACE Teacher, you set the tone for the success of your class team - through engaging lessons, an inspiring environment, and an approach that encourages thoughtful collaboration & teamwork.

You'll be expected to:

- **Attend the staff induction and assist centre set-up duties.**
- **Create lesson plans that are both academically sound and engaging for students, following the Dusemond ACE Guide.**
- **Utilise a variety of media and technology to enhance the learning experience.**
- **Guide students through a comprehensive understanding of the gender equality landscape.**
- **Utilize Care and Honesty to foster a meaningful research and problem-solving environment.**
- **Collaborate with the Academic Manager to review Student progress**
- **Keep accurate records of student attendance, assessments and progress.**

Competition modules ACE★

You will engage students in the competitive ACE programme which consists of three modules, each designed to challenge and inspire critical thinking and collaborative problem-solving on gender equality issues.

Boarding House supervision

Play an active role in residential life, fostering respect for each other (and curfew/quiet times!)

Community & pastoral care

Be alert to students' emotional and social needs and take appropriate action when needed.

Operational support

Assist with logistical tasks such as "herding groups" or occasional meal-time supervision.

If you thrive in the amazing environments we work so hard to create, you'll want to grow with us. Many first year staff return to become supervisors and managers.



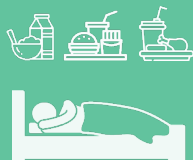
