Activities

The biggest part of an Activity Leader's role is in planning and running the schedule of on-site activities each day. The focus is on fun, varied and engaging activities and our ALs are the people who keep the students energised, positive and happy.

You'll be responsible for:

- Planning and coordinating activities with the team.
- Arranging equipment and materials for your activities.
- Running activities safely and keeping everyone involved.
- Bringing the "fun" to the sessions you run!
- Tidying / resetting / locking up spaces you've used.

Centre Set-up & Maintenance



Setting up the centre and keeping it looking good needs a big effort from day 1. Your help will be key!

If you thrive in the amazing environments we work so hard to create, you'll want to grow with us. Many first year staff return to become supervisors and managers.



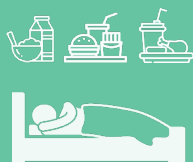
